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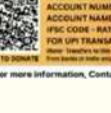
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POURING HEART IN LITTLE'S ART

October 17th, 2022

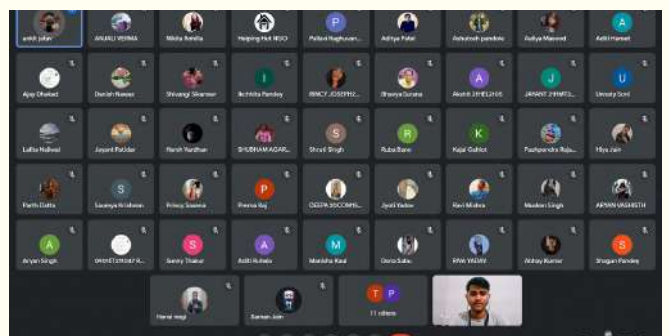

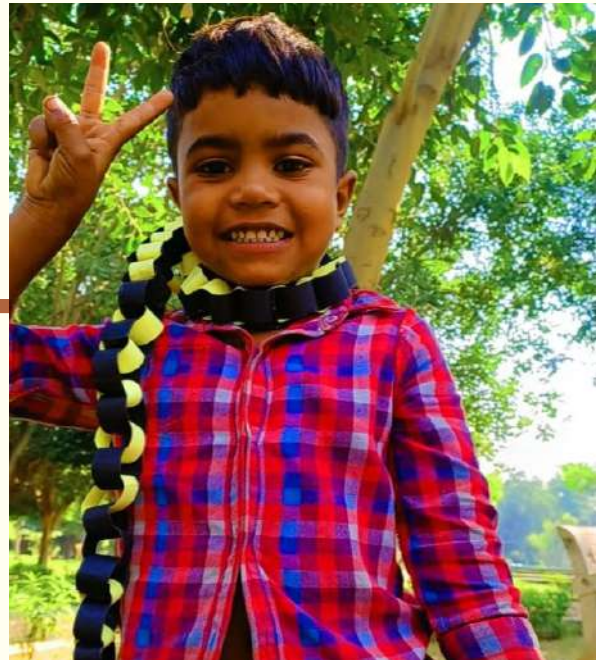

HEALTH CHECKUP CAMP
